BEST PRACTICE OF ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT IN THE WORKPLACE

In recognition that the legacy of asbestos in aging infrastructure is a current day problem for workers, contractors and subcontractors, Northern Transportables has adopted the following policy framework towards achieving best practice in asbestos management.

1. No amount of asbestos is to be removed by an employee from a worksite other than a sample sufficient for identification and analysis in accordance with Regulation 423 of the *Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Regulations*.
2. Where the presence of asbestos is assumed, identified or determined, Northern Transportables staff will cease works until such time that that a negative result is returned or that any asbestos has been removed by a licenced asbestos removalist in accordance with Regulation 423 of the *Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Regulations*.
3. The QHSE Administrator must have contact numbers readily available for both licenced asbestos assessors and licenced asbestos removalists.
4. Northern Transportables will engage suitably qualified/licenced subcontractors to undertake works where the removal of asbestos is involved.

This policy is reflected in Northern Transportables documentation:

- Asbestos Management Plan,
- Risk Register, and
- Safe Work Method Statement for Removal of Asbestos Sample.

Safety is a responsibility of all.
